The terrible thing about sin is the way it separates God and his people. So often our self-deceit, thoughtless choices or destructive life patterns are really means to hide from God. But Jesus is a great healer, showing us how to feel comfortable in God's presence once again. St Paul talks about the ongoing spiritual healing that happens for those who live in Christ. A tentmaker by profession, he uses the metaphor of physical death as merely a folding up of the tent of one's physical body, so the spirit can live on, "at home" with God forever.
