A Prophet is honored everywhere except among his own...

A PROPHET HAS BEEN AMONG THEM

Many people wrongly believe that a prophet predicts the future. Actually, prophets in the bible only occasionally make predictions, some never predict anything. The word that is usually translated "prophet" is the Hebrew word "nabi" which means "one who sees." In the biblical sense. this "seeing" actually means understanding, as in "Oh, I see!" Prophets are simply deeply sensitive people with a strong faith. They can "see" a connection between what is going on around them and the ideas of God. We might call them interpreters of God's sign language.
